Tom Cat's Lemonade and Teas was denied since he uses no local ingredients and Adobe Farms and Durango Juice Bar use local ingredients in compliance with the Rules and Regulations, Sec. 1, d, iii.

It was decided not to announce Ready to Eat and Beverage vendors until Cody has talked to all of them and verified times and compliance.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned to the Spring General Meeting.
