1. The board has moved to allow the vendor in question from the November 14th 2023 meeting to be a vendor at the 2023 harvest and holiday markets. Meeting minutes from November 14th 2023 reflect the change.
2. The Durango Farmers Market Board of Directors (BOD) has determined that it is not in the best interest of the Durango Farmers Market organization as a whole to have an ongoing conflict between two vendors potentially disrupting future markets and DFM committee work. Nor does the BOD desire to have to repeatedly discuss and deal with complaints, accusations, social media posts, or the like in BOD meetings
3. The vendors that have been in continued conflict with each other will receive a letter to notify them of their suspension from the 2024 market season and committees until the conflict between them is resolved. Notarized evidence of such conflict resolution must be provided to the BOD in writing and signed by both parties.
